

**Personent Hodie – Phonetic pronunciation for the Latin (HINTS:  
always flip the “r” if possible; the vowel O is pronounced more like an  
Aw)**

**Children’s Choir sings only verse 1 and the chorus of verse 3.**

1. Pear-so-nent Oh-dee-eh Vo-ches-poo-eh-roo-leh,
